OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

EDUCATION CENTER

- Sign in at station near door
- Building and bathrooms are **CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC** due to COVID19 precautions
- Check out the amazing views of the Cove from the back deck

VERNAL POOL TRAIL

- Entire loop is about 0.07 miles
- A very easy-to-walk trail and great spot to view birds

CAPTAIN'S TRAIL

- About 0.1 miles
- Trail leads out to the waterfront and great views of Captain Trash Wheel

MEADOW TRAIL

- About 0.16 miles to the piers, the entire loop (Meadow Trail and Gravel Road) is about 0.31 miles
- Trail winds through beautiful restored meadows

SYCAMORE TRAIL

- About 0.15 miles
- Walk on this trail to view a bald eagle's nest. This is the home of the only documented nesting bald eagle pair in Baltimore City!

WOODLAND TRAIL

- Entire loop is about 0.7 miles
- Features older trees and waterfront views

DRIFTWOOD TRAIL

- About 0.4 miles
- Enjoy views of Masonville Cove wetlands

PIER

- Enjoy fantastic views of Baltimore

DECEMBER ADVENTURES

Animals in the wild are typically shy, skittish, and sometimes don't like to be seen. They can hide in tall grass, in trees, and in dens, but they always leave behind evidence of their presence! The two most abundant pieces of evidence animals tend to leave behind are tracks (footprints) and droppings (scat). See if you can find tracks and scat of the following animals that frequent Masonville Cove! How many boxes can you check?


